





Getting Ready for Kindergarten





Build your child's independence by encouraging them to:





- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers and using a water bottle



- play games, take turns and compromise
- develop a consistent bedtime routine

First Days of Kindergarten









For the first day of classes, and every day that follows, please be sure to send your child to school with:

- A <u>backpack</u> large enough to hold a library book, a snack container and a water bottle
- Indoor <u>running shoes</u> with Velcro fasteners (shoes will be left at school) that your child can put on and take off independently
- Items for the <u>weather</u> (ie. hats, mittens)
- Clothing that is appropriate for <u>playing</u>, <u>creating</u> and <u>exploring</u>
- Spare set of clothing (socks, pants, shirt, undergarments)

**Please label all clothing, backpacks, shoes, lunch boxes and snack containers with your child's name **

No school for Kindergarten on Friday, August 30, 2024




Tuesday, September 3, 2024

Ways to be Involved









At School:

- volunteer in the classroom

Volunteer Clearance Procedure











Step 1: Prospective volunteers must first fill in an Annual Volunteer Registration Form. The school office will then provide you with a letter enabling you to obtain a police information check from the Calgary Police Service (CPS).

Step 2: Visit the CPS online system, <u>electronic Police Information Check</u> (<u>ePIC</u>), to obtain your police check using your CBE volunteer letter.

Step 3: Once you receive your clearance document from CPS you will need to share it with the school. This can be done through School Engage, inperson or by email.

Cost: Your security clearance is valid for five years and the cost is \$21.25. If cost is a barrier, please let the school know. School Council will pay the fee for anyone who is in need.
