

PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING

PLAY-APPROPRIATE CLOTHES & ITEMS

Clothing that is appropriate for **playing**, **creating** and **exploring**.

Weather items include: hats, mittens, boots

SPARE CLOTHES

Includes: socks, pants, shirt, undergarment
